



Exhibit Specifications for “Viola Liuzzo: An Exemplary Woman in Extraordinary Times”

Opening Banner:

- 1 Roll-able plastic banner measuring 7' H x 4' W

Text/Photo Panels (with accompanying labels):

- 3 Panels depicting Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Pres. Lyndon Johnson, and J. Edgar Hoover: 30" H x 24" W
- 4 Panels depicting scenes with King and Johnson: 24" H x 18" H
- 2 Panels depicting the Voting Rights Act and the Civil Rights Act: 17" H x 11" W
- 3 Panels depicting the Selma March plan: 17" H x 11" W
- 1 Panel describing events leading up to the Selma March plan: 22" H x 17" W
- 1 Panel with excerpts about arrest of Liuzzo's murder suspects: 22" H x 17" W
- 4 Retractable banner stands featuring civil rights timeline: 4' H x 7" W
- 1 Panel depicting Viola Liuzzo: 30" H x 21" W

Media:

- 3 Magazines relating to Liuzzo from the era; two copies of *Life* and one copy of *Ladies Home Journal*.
- 1 Portion of Liuzzo's FBI file: 11" H x 8.5" W x 4" D
- 1 DVD of Amelia Boynton's speech (a participant in the Selma March) recorded at Davenport University.
- 1 CD of gospel music including the Bethesda Christian Church Sanctuary Choir, the Fort Street Chorale, and the Brazeal Dennard Community Chorale.

Artwork:

- 1 Ceramic bust of Liuzzo 16" H x 1' W
- 1 Five-panel oil painting depicting Liuzzo, King, and Rosa Parks: 4' H x 2' W

Notes:

- 1) The exhibit, which occupies 90 linear feet of space, may be rented for a fee of **\$125 per week for a minimum of four weeks.**
- 2) All panels are for INDOOR USE ONLY.

3) All panels can be hung by Velcro on a fabric surface or by nail on plastered walls or placed on easels. Each banner is equipped with plastic hanging tabs.

4) The panels are made of Sintra (plastic) and have a warm tan background. The bust of Liuzzo and the five-panel oil painting must be hung in a lockable room. The magazines and FBI file must be exhibited in locked display cases.

5) The exhibit travels in 7 boxes: the opening banner travels in one box measuring 56" x 4.5" x 5". The rest of the exhibit travels in: one large (4.5' W x 3' H) and two medium (3'W x 2' H) shipping cases, one 20" square shipping case, one 4' L x 8" square cardboard box, and one 4' x 4' cardboard box. The exhibit must be picked up from and delivered back to the Michigan Women's Historical Center by minivan or covered pick-up truck at the renter's cost.

6) To supplement the exhibit, the renter might want to consider purchasing a copy of "Home of the Brave": a DVD documentary of Liuzzo's compelling story from Home Vision Entertainment.
